Pets on Jets



Air Charter Scotland is proud to have recently updated our requirements for carrying pets onboard, meaning we can now accept larger animals. The maximum weights and quantities are detailed in the table below. We hold DEFRA approval, so can accept arrivals into UK DEFRA approved airports.

Pet Travel Regulations

- A suitable harness and leash, provided by the owner and attached to the owner's seat belt, should be used to restrain the pet effectively during take-off, landing and turbulence.
- 🌺 The owner must confirm the dog is calm and controlled whilst travelling by air.
- All pets remain subject to the Pet Travel Scheme and must hold the required documentation and vaccinations.
- 🌺 The passenger responsible for the pet, must ensure they are carrying the required documentation for the destination.
- The requirements can differ depending on the destination. Typically required are a Pet Passport or Animal Health Certificate (AHC), Microchipping and a Rabies Vaccination.
- For arrival to the UK, the pet must have a Tapeworm treatment conducted between 120 and 24 hours prior to arrival in the UK. This must be recorded in the Pet Passport or AHC.
- 🐕 Air Charter Scotland can assist in checking entry requirements, so please do not hesitate to ask us.
- 🜺 🛮 All documentation must be provided to Air Charter Scotland no later than 24 hours prior to departure.
